GO FOR IT!

- ◆ Introduce or revisit the theme and outline what the challenge involves
- ◆ Recap plans of action from Day 2, Challenge D
- ◆ Use the group planning sheet and story board to remind students what their focus is
- ◆ Students create props and resources and rehearse the final performance
- ◆ Stop at regular intervals to refocus
- ◆ Remember practice makes perfect
